Dear Partner,

Greetings from the sunny Maldives!

We hope you, your teams and loved ones are staying safe during these unprecedented times.

We are pleased to inform you that we will resume operations of our Adaaran Resorts in the Maldives from end July 2020; with a strong belief that inspired and safe travel will be joyfully embraced by our international community, given the months of confinement.

Our resort, Adaaran Prestige Vadoo will commence operations from 27 July 2020; with Adaaran Select Meedhupparu, Adaaran Prestige Water Villas and Adaaran Club Rannalhi operational from 01 September 2020. The resorts will see a progressive opening of inventory, based on demand.

Adaaran Select Hudhuran Fushi is currently a quarantine centre under the purview of the Government. Owing to the resting period of the resort and following protocols once the resort is handed over to us, we are unable to commit to a reopening date at present. No sooner we are given a date of movement from the Government, we will share the proposed date of opening, with you. However, we are pleased to advise that any bookings made at Adaaran Select Hudhuran Fushi between 15 July 2020 and date of commencement, will be upgraded to Adaaran Select Meedhupparu at the same rate together with transfers.

For reservations made at any of our other Adaaran Resorts between 15 July 2020 to 31 August 2020, we request that the guests rebook their stays at the same resort on any date between 01 September 2020 to 23 December 2020; subject to availability. There will be no additional charges and the original reservation rate for accommodation and transfers will be respected. When rebooking, we request the guests to share the previous booking voucher or reference number in order to honour the original value.

Our facilities will remain uninterrupted for our mutual guest' pleasure. Given safety concerns, we have made a decision to make our multiple restaurant offerings open on rotation basis at **Adaaran Select Meedhupparu** with three of the four restaurants made available daily, on rotation basis. There will be no change in the F&B outlet offering at the other Adaaran Resorts.
